Parents Volunteer Opportunities 家长参与

4. Report an absence, call your students' class teacher and get homework assignment from the teacher

Tuition Policies 学费制度

1. Full (annual or quarter) tuition fee must be paid to attend classes. Late fee will be charged to late registration.
2. For drop-offs, parents need to fill Drop-off Request form to get tuition refund
3. Processing fee will be charged for drop-offs requests
4. Drop-off requests are processed quarterly
5. Refund for drop-off, if annual tuition was paid, is the remaining balance after quarter and week tuition fee are met.
6. Refund for drop-off, if quarter tuition was paid, is the remaining balance after week tuition fee are met.
7. No refund for a class absence due to personal reasons such as illness or vacations.

3. Run or Chase in lobby during recess 不要在走廊跑跳追逐
4. Go to areas that are not permitted 不要到不许可的地方：楼梯，二楼，电梯
5. Bring color or glass bottle drinks to Sunday school 不要携带颜色饮料或玻璃装饮料到学校
